This award will be bestowed on the student who best communicates how the tenets embedded in the Four Way Test may affect their character, life or professional journey or could have altered past decisions.

The Four-Way Test:

In 1932, Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor created The Four-Way Test to save his company from bankruptcy and set a new standard for customer relations, ethics and life's values.

Before we think or do, give thought,

Is it the TRUTH?

Is it FAIR to all concerned?

Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?

Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

Application process:

The applicant must be a graduating student of Port St. Joe High School. To be considered, the applicant with input from their family must complete an essay of one and half to three pages addressing their recognition of the Four-Way Test shown above.
